1. How many fish species are there in Ontario?

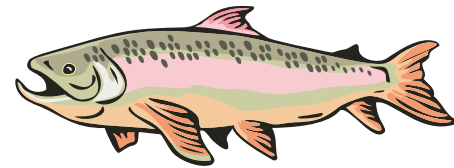
2. What is the largest fish species ever caught in the province?
